



Commonwealth Standards Network: Side event of ARSO meetings Wednesday 19th June 17.30-18.30

Background:

At the 2018 Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting, the UK Prime Minister announced the establishment of the Commonwealth Standards Network (CSN) to tackle non-tariff barriers and promote strong trade amongst all Commonwealth states through the participation, adoption and implementation of existing international standards.

"The network will provide a significant opportunity for national standards experts to collaborate and share best practice and it will empower developing countries to have a stronger voice in the international standards community – something that has benefits on a global scale." *UK Prime Minister Theresa May at the Commonwealth Head of Governments Meeting, 16th April 2018.*

The following CSN outputs will be delivered by April 2020:

- Online portal, to support information exchange and peer to peer support;
- Framework of International Standards, and a Toolkit to support their implementation;
- 30 in-country training sessions, focussed on raising awareness of the benefits of international standards, and to assist countries to take an active role in international standards development;
- Focussed in-country technical assistance programmes to support NSB development.
